13	(a) On or before December 15, 2024, the Cannabis Control Board shall
14	submit to the Senate Committees on Government Operations and on Economic
15	Development, Housing and General Affairs and the House Committees on
16	Government Operations and Military Affairs and on Commerce and Economic
17	Development a report regarding the siting and licensing of outdoor cannabis
18	cultivation. The report shall:
19	(1) summarize the current impact of outdoor cultivation on local
20	municipalities;

1	(2) summarize the impact of establishing various siting requirements to
2	existing licensed outdoor cultivators;
3	(3) address whether and how to authorize municipalities to establish
4	local cultivation districts;
5	(4) address whether and how outdoor cultivation of cannabis should be
6	entitled to the rebuttable presumption that cultivation does not constitute a
7	nuisance under 12 V.S.A. chapter 195; and
8	(5) recommend whether local cannabis control commissions established
9	pursuant to 7 V.S.A. chapter 33 should be granted additional authority to
10	regulate outdoor cannabis cultivators.
11	(b) The Cannabis Control Board shall consult with the Vermont League of
12	Cities and Towns, the Cannabis Equity Coalition, the Vermont Medical
13	Society, the Cannabis Retailers Association of Vermont, and other interested
14	stakeholders in developing the report required under subsection (a) of this
15	section.
16	(c) As part of the report required under subsection (a) of this section, the
17	Cannabis Control Board shall address the impact of modifying the law
18	governing cannabis advertising.
19	Sec. 19. EFFECTIVE DATES
20	This act shall take effect on passage, except that:
