Good evening. My name is Juanita Wade. I am a resident of New Haven and a volunteer for the Vermont Food Bank. Please address the ongoing needs of Vermonters facing food insecurity by establishing a base appropriation of \$3 million in the FY24 state budget for the Vermont Food Bank.

The Vermont Food Bank serves Vermont's most vulnerable populations. Volunteering in Addison and Rutland counties at the Foodbank's Veggie Van Go food distribution sites, I see that vulnerability and corresponding relief families feel when shares of fresh produce are loaded into their cars.
