As you prepare the FY25 Budget, I ask that you SUPPORT \$10.82 million for the implementation of the housing pilots for

adults with developmental disabilities begun with planning grants from Act 186. Furthermore, I ask that you support

funding the annual development of stable, service-supported housing for adults with developmental disabilities. Those

Act 187 pilot projects are just a first learning step towards creating a robust network of community-based, collective

housing opportunities with support staff for developmentally disabled adults who require substantial care. Estimates

suggest that over 600 placements are needed statewide right now.

My friend, Sarah Danks, turns 21 next month. She has a huge smile, loves dancing and music, and craves social interaction

with friends. She also has Down Syndrome and several serious medical conditions and language challenges that

together require 24-7 care. Right now there is nowhere for her to live in Vermont when her mother is unable to fill those needs.

Please do not forget her, and other such vulnerable adults as you consider expansion of low cost housing options in

Vermont.
