PROJECT PURPOSE

- To bring water to the top of Killington Road for the development of the long-awaited ski village and to bring water down Killington Road to improve water quality for the many properties with contaminated wells.
- To upgrade Killington Road to increase capacity, improve the operations and safety for all users, and maintain efficient travel through the corridor.
- To provide municipal water to potential affordable and workforce housing sites on Killington Road.



FUNDING INFORMATION

Funding is provided through TIF, ARPA, the State Revolving Fund, a Catalyst Grant, a Community Recovery & Revitalization Program grant, and USDA Rural Development financing.



CONSTRUCTION TIMING

Phase 1 has been approved by voters and is under construction, to be completed by 2026. Future phases will require review and approval by the Selectboard, Vermont Economic Progress Council, and the voters.


