

School District Supervisory Union






Supervisory Union Multiple School Districts,

A school district can take a variety of forms depending on three factors:


- The number of towns for which it is responsible
- The grades for which it is organized
- The manner it which it provides education




A school district can take a variety of forms depending on three factors:

- The number of towns for which it is responsible
 - One town
 - Multiple towns = Union School District
- The grades for which it is organized
 - All grades PreK-12
 - If for multiple towns = Unified Union School District
 - Some subset of all grades
 - If for multiple towns = Union Elementary School District or Union High School District
- The manner it which it provides education
 - Operates all grades for which it is organized
 - Pays tuition for all grades for which it is organized
 - Operates some grades and pays tuition for all others
