1	TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:
2	The Committee on Government Operations to which was referred a
3	proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Vermont entitled
4	"Proposal 1" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5	recommends that the proposal be amended by striking out the proposal in its
6	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	PROPOSAL 1
8	Sec. 1. PURPOSE
9	This proposal would amend the Constitution of the State of Vermont to
10	allow the General Assembly to establish by law qualifications for individuals
11	to be elected to and hold certain county offices and to be removed from office
12	for failure to meet or to maintain those qualifications.
13	Sec. 2. Section 50 of Chapter II of the Vermont Constitution is amended to
14	read:
15	§ 50. ELECTION OF ASSISTANT JUDGES, SHERIFFS, AND STATE'S
16	ATTORNEYS
17	The Assistant Judges shall be elected by the voters of their respective
18	districts as established by law. Their judicial functions shall be established by
19	law. Their term of office shall be four years and shall commence on the first
20	day of February next after their election. The General Assembly may establish
21	by law qualifications for the election to and holding of such office and

1	procedures for removal from such office for failure to meet or to maintain the
2	required qualifications.
3	Sheriffs shall be elected by the voters of their respective districts as
4	established by law. Their term of office shall be four years and shall
5	commence on the first day of February next after their election. The General
6	Assembly may establish by law qualifications for the election to and holding of
7	such office and procedures for removal from such office for failure to meet or
8	to maintain the required qualifications.
9	State's Attorneys shall be elected by the voters of their respective districts
10	as established by law. Their term of office shall be four years and shall
11	commence on the first day of February next after their election. The General
12	Assembly may establish by law qualifications for the election to and holding of
13	such office and procedures for removal from such office for failure to meet or
14	to maintain the required qualifications.
15	Sec. 3. Section 51 of Chapter II of the Vermont Constitution is amended to
16	read:
17	§ 51. ELECTION OF JUDGES OF PROBATE
18	Judges of Probate shall be elected by the voters of their respective districts
19	as established by law. The General Assembly may establish by law
20	qualifications for the election to and holding of such office and procedures for
21	removal from such office for failure to meet or to maintain the required

1	qualifications. Their term of office shall be four years and shall commence on
2	the first day of February next after their election.
3	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
4	The amendments set forth in Secs. 2 and 3 shall become a part of the
5	Constitution of the State of Vermont on the first Tuesday after the first
6	Monday of November 2026 when ratified and adopted by the people of this
7	State in accordance with the provisions of 17 V.S.A. chapter 32.
