12	Health Care Advocate; the Office of the Child, Youth, and Family Advocate;
13	Disability Rights Vermont; the Office of the Long-Term Care Ombudsman;
14	and other relevant stakeholders, shall develop recommendations either for
15	restructuring the existing Agency of Human Services or for dividing the
16	existing Agency of Human Services into two separate agencies.
17	(b) On or before February 1, 2025, the Secretary shall provide the
18	recommendations to the House Committees on Government Operations and
19	Military Affairs, on Health Care, and on Human Services and the Senate
20	Committees on Government Operations and on Health and Welfare, including
21	the following:

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1	(1) how the recommended configuration would center the needs of and		
2	lead to better outcomes for the individuals and families served by the Agency		
3	and its departments;		
4	(2) how the recommended configuration could improve collaboration,		
5	integration, and alignment of the services currently provided by the Agency		
6	and its departments;		
7	(3) how the recommended configuration could address the workforce		
8	and personnel capacity challenges that the Agency and its departments		
9	encounter;		
10	(4) how the recommended configuration could address the technology		
11	and facility challenges that the Agency and its departments encounter;		
12	(5) a transition and implementation plan for the recommended		
13	configuration that is designed to minimize confusion and disruption for		
14	individuals and families served by the Agency and its departments, as well as		
15	for Agency and departmental staff;		
16	(6) a proposed organizational chart for the recommended configuration;		
17	and		
18	(7) the estimated costs or savings associated with the recommended		
19	configuration.
