STATE OF VERMONT

VERMONT STATE FLOOD BOND. - LOAN OF 1927.

Know all men by these presents that the State of Vermont, for value received, promises to pay to bearer, on the first day of December, 1937,

ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS,

with interest amounting at the rate of three and three-quarters per cent (3 3/4%) per annum, payable semi-annually upon presentation and surrender of the annexed coupons as they respectively mature. Both principal and interest are payable in gold coin of the United States of America at the present standard of weight and fineness in the City of New York or in said State of Vermont at the office thereof of the Treasurer of the State, or at holder's option, either in the Borough of Manhattan, City of New York, State of New York, at the office therein of J. P. Morgan & Co. or in the City of Boston, State of Massachusetts, at the office therein of The Atlantic National Bank of Boston. This bond is one of an authorized series of eight thousand five hundred (\$8500) bonds of like amount and tenor, except as to maturities, numbered 10000 inclusive, issued for the purposes mentioned in and under authority of an act in conformity with an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Vermont, approved November 30, 1927, entitled "An Act to enable the State of Vermont to Issue Bonds for the purposes therein named." Said bonds mature serially, namely, four hundred and twenty-five (425) on the first day of December of each of the years 1929 to 1948, both inclusive. For the payment of the principal and interest of this bond, the faith and credit of said State of Vermont are hereby pledged.

THIS BOND IS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION IN VERMONT.

All acts, formalities and conditions in or in relation to the validity hereof have been performed and complied with, but this bond shall not be obligatory until authenticated by the certificate of The Atlantic National Bank of Boston endorsed hereon.

In Witness whereof, the State has caused its seal to be here to be affixed, and this instrument to be signed in its name and behalf by its Treasurer, countersigned and signed by its Secretary of State, and countersigned by its Auditor of Accounts, and the countersignatures hereof annexed to be authenticated by the fac-simile signature of its Treasurer, this first day of December, 1927.
