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1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No. 17		
3	entitled "An act relating to sheriff reforms" respectfully reports that it has		
4	considered the same and recommends that the report of the Committee on		
5	Government Operations be amended as follows:		
6	First: In Sec. 5, 24 V.S.A. § 291a, by striking out subsection (f) in its		
7	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (f) to read as follows:		
8	(f) An agreement or contract for sheriff's departments to provide law		
9	enforcement or security services to county and State courthouses shall be		
10	subject to a single, statewide contracted rate of pay for such services over all		
11	county and State courthouses.		
12	Second: By adding one new section to be Sec. 5a to read as follows:		
13	Sec. 5a. USE OF ADMINISTRATIVE OVERHEAD FUNDS IN 2023		
14	AND 2024		
15	Notwithstanding 24 V.S.A. § 291a(c), in calendar years 2023 and 2024, a		
16	sheriff's department may use funds derived from contract administrative		
17	overhead fees to make supplemental salary payments to a sheriff of not more		
18	than 50 percent of the annual compensation for a sheriff, provided that the		
19	sheriff has been in office at least two years, and to any employee of a sheriff's		
20	department or a sheriff that has been in office less than two years of not more		
21	than 10 percent of the annual compensation for the employee. Funds derived		

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1	from contract administrative overhead fees shall not be used for any other		
2	bonus or supplemental employment benefit payment.		
3	Third: In Sec. 11, Sheriff's Departments Oversight Task Force; report, by		
4	striking out subsection (c) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new		
5	subsection (c) to read as follows:		
6	(c) Powers and duties. The Sheriff's Departments Oversight Task Force		
7	shall consider issues relating to oversight of sheriff's departments, including		
8	the following:		
9	(1) creating and maintaining policies and best practices to be included in		
10	standard operating procedures manuals and policy manuals;		
11	(2) increasing efficiency and equity in the delivery of public safety		
12	services by sheriff's departments;		
13	(3) the compensation structure and levels of sheriffs, deputies, and		
14	departmental staff, including salaries, overtime, retirement, benefits, and		
15	bonuses;		
16	(4) the duties of sheriffs, as related to both law enforcement and		
17	administration of sheriff's departments;		
18	(5) oversight of sheriffs, as related to both conduct and administration of		
19	sheriff's departments;		
20	(6) creating a sustainable funding model for sheriff's departments that is		
21	not based on contracts for services;		

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1	(7) reorganizing the Department of State's Attorneys and Sheriffs to		
2	better provide oversight and support for State's Attorneys and sheriffs; and		
3	(8) determining the scope and timing of public sector management		
4	training that sheriffs should receive upon election and on a continuing basis to		
5	ensure departmental operations and management of public funds are consistent		
6	with generally accepted standards.
