## 1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2	The Committee on Health and Welfare to which was referred House Bill		
3	No. 206 entitled "An act relating to miscellaneous changes affecting the duties		
4	of the Department of Vermont Health Access" respectfully reports that it has		
5	considered the same and recommends that the Senate propose to the House that		
6	the bill be amended by striking out Sec. 5, effective date, in its entirety and		
7	inserting in lieu thereof three new sections to be Secs. 5–7 to read as follows:		
8	Sec. 5. BLUEPRINT FOR HEALTH; DEPARTMENT OF VERMONT		
9	HEALTH ACCESS; REPORT		
10	(a) On or before December 1, 2023, the Department of Vermont Health		
11	Access shall submit a report to the House and Senate Committees on		
12	Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, and the House		
13	Committee on Health Care containing a breakdown of Blueprint for Health		
14	per-member per-month payments to patient-centered medical homes and		
15	financial contributions for community health teams made by each payer for		
16	fiscal year 2023. The report shall include monetary totals and the number of		
17	attributed patients for each payer for each of the following types of health care		
18	coverage:		
19	(1) individual and small group market health plans;		
20	(2) fully insured large group market health plans;		

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1	(3) employer-sponsored health plans administered by the payer as a
2	third-party administrator;
3	(4) Medicaid; and
4	(5) Medicare.
5	(b) To the extent the Department did not collect per-member per-month
6	payments or financial contributions from all third-party administrators for
7	employer-sponsored health plans for fiscal year 2023, the Department shall
8	include in its report the information required in subsection (a) of this section as
9	if the Department had collected those payments and contributions, including
10	information on how many attributed patients fall under employer-sponsored
11	plans for each payer.
