The Office of the Health Care Advocate, in order to protect and promote patients' and consumers' interests in accordance with the Office's duties under Chapter 229 of this title, shall have the right to receive and review in full, including any exhibits, attachments, appendixes, or other supplementary materials incorporated thereto, the preliminary report of any examination conducted under this section filed with the Commissioner, the pharmacy benefit manager's submissions or rebuttals to the report, the final examination report adopted by the Commissioner, and the Commissioner's order adopting the report. The Office of the Health Care Advocate shall not disclose any information provided to the Office pursuant to this subdivision until such material is made available by the Commissioner further disclose any confidential or proprietary information provided to the Office pursuant to the subdivision.
