

I hope this email finds you well. I wanted to reach out to introduce myself – I'm the State Policy and Advocacy Regional Manager for Susan G. Komen, Breast Cancer Nonprofit. I saw that H. 621, which eliminates out-of-pocket patient cost-sharing for follow-up breast diagnostic and supplemental imaging will be read to your committee tomorrow. This is a bill that we strongly support and if I can be helpful in any way, please do not hesitate to reach out. I'm sure you are already aware, but during the house committee sessions, DFR stated this bill will not defrayal state costs and the bill also has no fiscal note attached.

Also, similar legislation has already passed in 20 other states including, Connecticut, Maine, Maryland, Delaware, New York, Oklahoma, Texas, Georgia, Missouri, and Washington. I attached a map to show you where this bill has passed and where legislation is also pending which includes Massachusetts, New Hampshire and Rhode Island. If you would like any further information from any of these states, please let me know and I would be happy to help.
