

Thank you for considering H.766, a bill to ameliorate the prior authorization madness.

I am writing in strong support.

Reducing prior authorization madness will improve time clinicians spend with patients, instead of doing mindless and alienating administrative work. The impact will therefore be to give patients more tuned-in and available clinicians at the same time it ameliorates health care worker burnout and attrition.
