
**MISSION:** to reduce the burden of cancer in Vermont and northern New York through research, clinical care, community outreach, and education.

- > Access to up to \$5M in additional NIH research funding each year;
- > Attracts talented researchers, educators and clinicians to VT.

### COMMUNITY OUTREACH $\divideontimes$


