House FY24-FY25 Capital Budget Adjustment (H.882) Compared to the Governor's Recommend

Bonding Capacity:

- HCI identified \$396,127 in additional reallocations compared to Gov. Rec. Of this, \$378,180 is from an FY22 appropriation for the demolition of the Windsor Correctional Facility.
- The Gov. Rec. Capital Bill Adjustment left \$640,000 in available bonding capacity unallocated.
- Therefore, the total bonding capacity available to HCI is \$1,036,128 higher than the Governor's recommended capital bill appropriations.

Bonded Appropriations:

Cash Fund B – IIJA Reserve:

The House-passed FY25 budget (H.883) unreserves \$5m from the \$14.5m reserved in the second cash fund subaccount for known State match requirement for IIJA funding in FY26-FY27. This \$5m would leverage \$25m in federal funds. The anticipated needs in this space over the next ten years are estimated to exceed \$2b, and current demand through FY24 exceeds total available IIJA funding by \$200m.
