## Vermont Judiciary Mission Statement

## Backlogs

- Backlogs existed pre-pandemic
- Pandemic impacts exacerbated backlogs
  - Jury trials halted for over a year
  - Pivot to remote hearings and new CMS/e-filing systems at start of pandemic
  - Inadequate HVAC; reduced workforce levels

• Criminal 106%

• Civil 108%

• Domestic 98%

• Juvenile 100%

• Probate 102%

• Judicial Bureau 101%



## Steps to Address Backlogs

- Input from stakeholders
- State-wide and unit specific backlog plans
- On-going review of pending cases
- Data clean-up
- Next event set in each case
- Priority scheduling/Use of retired judges
- Jury draw and trial dates added



## Challenges Encountered

- Judicial vacancies 5 during 2023
- Inadequate court staff levels disparities across units



## **Judiciary Needs**

- Three Superior Judge Positions
  - Northern Float
  - Statewide Treatment Court Float
  - Statewide Juvenile Docket Float
- Ten Judicial Assistants
  - Statewide formula
  - Equitable level of court staff resources
