2 Senator Harrison moves that the Senate propose to the House that the bill be
3 amended by adding a new section to be Sec. 37a to read as follows:

4 Sec. 37a. TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT STUDY

5 (a) On or before December 15, 2025, the Agency of Transportation, after
6 consultation with the Department of Housing and Community Development,
7 the Vermont League of Cities and Towns, the Vermont Association of
8 Planning and Development Agencies, the Vermont Public Transportation
9 Association, and the Natural Resources Board, shall review the revenue
10 received by the State, both current and projected, for transit support through
11 Act 250 and the revenue and benefits to developers, to the State, and to the
12 community received through transportation impact fees, and shall suggest
13 processes to preserve these revenues, requirements, and benefits.

14 (b) The Agency shall consider including transportation demand
15 management and subsidy requirements in development review authority for
16 municipalities, the authority or ability of the Agency of Transportation to
17 enforce transportation impact fees as part of the municipal process, and any
18 other proposals.

19 (c) The Agency shall hear from a diverse group of stakeholders including
20 developers, local government officials, alternative transportation organizations,
21 transit providers, and financial institutions.

1 (d) On or before December 15, 2025, the Agency of Transportation shall
2 submit a report to the Senate Committees on Economic Development, Housing
3 and General Affairs, on Natural Resources and Energy, and on Transportation
4 and the House Committees on Transportation and on Environment and Energy
5 with its findings and recommendations.
