I'm writing to plead that you strongly oppose S.258.

I fundamentally opposed the stance that the fish and wildlife board takes an advisory role and acquiesces power to those who don't engage in outdoor recreation such as hunting, fishing and trapping. This bill appears to be a bid to put members on the board who have already established they want to end such practices.
