#### How it works

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MileageSmart offers low-income Vermonters 25% - up to \$5,000 - off of a used high-efficient vehicle.



#### **Applicant Eligibility**


- Be a Vermont resident
- Be at or below 80% State Median Income
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Not be claimed as a dependent

#### **Vehicle Eligibility**

- Be pre-owned
- Be rated at least 40 MPG/MPGe combined
- Be purchased at a Vermont dealership
- Be at or below J.D Power Clean Retail Value
- Have a sale price of less than \$40,000

# **Tiered Incentive**

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


What's your budget for this upcoming vehicle purchase?

- \*Pulled from applicant survey that was used to identify why approved applicants had not yet purchased a vehicle. 138 responses.
- Effective January 1, 2024, for participants who receive 3Squares/SNAP benefits the MileageSmart incentive is \$5,000 off the purchase price (the 25% is dropped).
- This change came as a result of surveying MileageSmart participants and understanding that those on the lowest end of the MileageSmart income eligibility range were least likely to access the full \$5,000.

# **Energy & Dollars Saved**


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- 837 Vermonters purchased high-efficiency vehicles using the MileageSmart incentive. Over \$3.5 million has been invested with an average incentive of \$4,461.30
- Year over year more incentive dollars are being invested into electrified vehicles. In 2021, 59% of all vehicles purchased using the MileageSmart incentive were hybrid vehicles and 41% were either PHEVs or EVs. In 2023, 42% of all vehicles purchased using the MileageSmart incentive were hybrid vehicles and 58% were either PHEVs or EVs.

### Growth

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


In 2023, there was an increase in the rate of approved applicants purchasing vehicles through the program. The key drivers included:

- Increased inventory of MileageSmart eligible vehicles
- Interest rates stabilizing
- Participating dealerships continue to increase (80 to 90 in 2023)

### Growth






- Since the inception of the program MileageSmart has connected with over 90 Vermont dealerships, sharing information with management and sales teams via webinars and VADA outreach.
- MileageSmart takes advantage of external outreach opportunities such as broadcasted interviews, presenting in webinars, and attending community meetings of energy and climate groups.
- MileageSmart engages with active applicants, supporting their car search with email updates of eligible vehicles at the participating dealerships.

### **Budget**

Projected growth in 2024 is reflective of the increase in demand for the program. There are four factors that we see accelerating the program in 2024:

- Two-tier incentive that improves accessibility of program
- Additional staff required
- Technology upgrades
- Increased inventory of eligible vehicles
