3 **PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO: Sec. 2(10)(A):**

4 (10) Complete streets.

5 (A) Secs. 28–31 of this act amend State law to define and adopt a
6 State policy on complete streets, require more transparency when certain State-
7 and municipally managed projects do not incorporate complete streets
8 principles, and require the maintenance of a web-accessible and web-
9 searchable data source and annual reporting related to complete streets.

10 **PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO: Sec. 30, § 2404:**

11 § 2404. ANNUAL REPORT; PUBLIC DATA SOURCE

12 (a) Annual report. Notwithstanding 2 V.S.A. § 20(d), the Agency shall
13 annually, on or before September 1 starting in 2025, submit a report detailing
14 the State’s efforts in following the complete streets policy established in
15 section 2402 of this chapter during the previous fiscal year to the House and
16 Senate Committees on Transportation.

17 (b) Public data source.

18 (1) The Agency of Transportation shall maintain a web-accessible and
19 web-searchable data source dedicated to complete streets on the Agency’s
20 website that shall contain information on all State-managed transportation
21 projects that have been bid since January 1, 2023, including a description of

1 the project, the location of the project, which complete streets principles were
2 incorporated in the project, as applicable, and an explanation as to which
3 circumstance or circumstances contained in subsection 2403(a) of this chapter
4 existed in the case of projects not incorporating complete streets principles.

5 (2) The web-accessible and web-searchable data source required under
6 this subsection shall be updated on at least an annual basis.

7 **PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO SEC. 31:**

8 Sec. 31. IMPLEMENTATION; PUBLIC **DATA SOURCE**

9 The Agency shall create and **make accessible to the general public the web-**
10 **accessible and web-searchable data source** required under 19 V.S.A. § 2404(b),
11 as added by Sec. 30 of this act, on or before January 1, 2024.
