11	the Chairs of the House and Senate Committees on Transportation, is
12	authorized to lease or otherwise arrange for the continued operation of all or
13	any State-owned railroad property to any responsible person, provided that
14	approval for the operation, if necessary, is granted by the federal Surface
15	Transportation Board under 49 C.F.R. Part 1150 (certificate to construct,
16	acquire, or operate railroad lines). The transaction shall be subject to any
17	further terms and conditions as in the opinion of the Secretary are necessary
18	and appropriate to accomplish the purpose of this chapter.
19	(b) To preserve continuity of service on State-owned railroads, the

Secretary may enter into a short-term lease or operating agreement, for a term

not to exceed six months, with a responsible railroad operator. Within 10 days

1	of entering into any lease or agreement, the Secretary shall report the details of
2	the transaction to the members of the House and Senate Committees on
3	Transportation.
4	(c) The Secretary shall notify the House and Senate Committees on
5	Transportation or, if the General Assembly is not in session, the Joint
5	Transportation Oversight Committee when there are 12 months remaining on
7	the lease for any State-owned railroad property, and when there are 12 months
3	remaining on a lease extension for any State-owned railroad property.
