**Act No. 85 (H.549). An act relating to eligibility of sentenced or detained individuals to obtain a State-issued nondriver identification card, replacement operator's license, or replacement learner's permit**

**Subjects: Corrections; motor vehicles; nondriver identification card**

The act provides individuals leaving correctional facilities with nondriver identification cards, replacement operator's licenses, or replacement learner's permits at no cost. The act directs the Department of Corrections and Department of Motor Vehicles to provide eligible individuals sentenced to six or more months with a replacement operator's license or replacement learner's permit at no cost upon their release from a correctional facility, in addition to prior law requiring provision of a nondriver identification card. The act further directs the Department of Corrections to provide eligible individuals detained pending trial for six or more months with the documents necessary for a nondriver identification card, replacement operator's license, or replacement learner's permit upon release, which the individual can present to the Department of Motor Vehicles to obtain the credential at no cost.
