Act No. 101 (H.814). An act relating to neurological rights and the use of artificial intelligence technology in health and human services

Subjects: Health; human services; health insurance; mental health; artificial intelligence; neurological rights

This act expresses legislative intent with respect to artificial intelligence and recognizes individuals' neurological rights. It also modifies the membership of the Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council, extends the Council's continued existence until June 30, 2030, and directs the Council to report to the General Assembly by January 15, 2027, on topics including protections for neurological rights and the ethical and responsible use of artificial intelligence in health care, human services, education, public participation, and public finance.
