9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to reduce the use
10	of seclusion and restraint on children and youth who are in the custody of the
11	Department for Children and Families and participating in a residential
12	program. This bill proposes to improve seclusion and restraint data collection
13	by defining seclusion and restraint in 33 V.S.A. § 3206 and requiring more
14	consistent reporting by residential programs serving children and youth in the
15	custody of the Department. It proposes to require that ongoing modifications
16	to the Department's IT system include processes for collecting and integrating
17	data pertaining to seclusion and restraint. Lastly, this bill proposes to require
18	enhanced professional development on alternatives to seclusion and restraint
19	for the staff of residential programs serving children and youth in the custody
20	of the Department.
