9 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to designate  
10 November as the Vermont Month of the Veteran.

11 An act relating to designating November as the Vermont Month of the  
12 Veteran

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

15 It is the intent of the General Assembly to honor the special value of the  
16 military service that the veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces have contributed to  
17 the security and well-being of our nation by designating November as the  
18 Vermont Month of the Veteran.

1       Sec. 2. 1 V.S.A. § 378 is added to read:

2       § 378. VERMONT MONTH OF THE VETERAN

3       November of each year is designated as the Vermont Month of the Veteran.

4       Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

5       This act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
