Subject: Commerce and trade; workforce development; AmeriCorps

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to (1) require Vermont State colleges and universities to offer in-state tuition for AmeriCorps members, (2) exempt recipients of the federal Segal AmeriCorps Education Award from paying State taxes on monies received from that reward, (3) exempt AmeriCorps members from paying State taxes on funds received through the AmeriCorps living allowance, (4) enact a policy that provides a preference in hiring AmeriCorps members for State employment vacancies, (5) provide a State education award that matches the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award to a student who performed AmeriCorps service in Vermont and is enrolled at a Vermont postsecondary institution, and (6) dedicate State funds to AmeriCorps program development.
