2	with this chapter.
3	(b) A person who violates any of the provisions of subsection (a) of this
4	section shall be subject to the penalties provided in 3 V.S.A. § 127. Unless a
5	person has earned a bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree from a social work
6	program accredited by the Council of Social Work Education or its successor,
7	the person shall not:
8	(1) use the title "social worker" or any initials associated with the title;

10	(2) advertise services under the description of "social worker."
