Subject: Agriculture; pesticides; rodenticides

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prohibit the use by any person of both first- and second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides in the State, including use by commercial applicators. The bill also would ban the sale, including internet sales, of first- and second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides in the State. The bill also would authorize certain exemptions to the prohibition on the use of first- and second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides when needed by the Department of Fish and Wildlife to control pests or when no other pest control method would be effective. In addition, the bill would restrict use of any other legal rodenticides, such as bromethalin rodenticides, near wildlife refuges, State parks, wildlife management areas, or other ecologically sensitive areas.
