16	stations, designated by the Commissioner as inspection stations, for the
17	purpose of determining whether those motor vehicles are properly equipped
18	and maintained in good mechanical condition; provided, however, the.
19	(B)(i) The scope of the safety inspection of a motor vehicle other
20	than a school bus or a commercial motor vehicle shall be limited to parts or

1	systems that are relevant to the vehicle's safe operation, and such vehicles shall
2	not fail the safety portion of the inspection unless the condition of the part or
3	system poses or may pose a an imminent danger to the operator or to other
4	highway users.
5	(ii) If a part or system is not in good mechanical condition but
6	does not pose an imminent danger to the operator or other highway users, the
7	inspection station shall provide the owner or operator of the vehicle with
8	written documentation of the condition of the part or system and recommended
9	actions that may be taken to restore the part or system to good mechanical
10	condition. The written documentation shall be signed by the vehicle operator
11	or owner and a copy shall be kept in the motor vehicle.
