16	§ 2302. STATE CHAIR TO CALL CAUCUS
17	(a) The chair of the State committee of a party shall set a date for members
18	of the party to meet in caucus in their respective towns. The date shall be
19	between September 10 and September 30, inclusive, in the month of
20	September in each odd-numbered year.

2	§ 2306. PROCEDURE UPON FAILURE TO HOLD CAUCUS
3	If the voters of the party residing in any town fail to hold a caucus on the
4	day designated by the State chair, the county chair or any three or more voters
5	of the party residing in the town may call and hold a caucus at any time
6	thereafter, in the manner provided in pursuant to the procedures in sections
7	2303 through 2305 of this chapter. Those The county chair or the voters
8	calling the caucus shall designate one person among them to perform the duties
9	prescribed in of the town chair pursuant to section 2303 for the town chair of
10	this chapter.
