Subject: Agriculture; food; single-use plastics; price look-up stickers

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that if a wholesale or retail seller of food attaches a price look-up (PLU) sticker to produce, the PLU sticker shall not be made of plastic and shall be compostable.

For purposes of the bill, "compostable" would mean the sticker is made of a natural fiber or meets industrial compost quality standards and uses a food grade adhesive for attachment to the produce. The bill would be effective July 1, 2028 to coincide with the European Union's planned adoption of compostable PLU stickers.
