Subject: Human services; continuing care retirement communities; assessment

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
Agency of Human Services to conduct an assessment regarding the benefits of  
increasing the number of continuing care retirement communities in the State's  
designated growth centers. The assessment shall examine the efficient  
provision of health care to elders and their communities; expanding housing  
and other independent living options; social opportunities for elders; walkable,  
bikeable, and transit-friendly communities; and accessible, inclusive public  
spaces that encourage smart growth and infill development.
