Subject: Court procedure; negligence actions; post-traumatic stress disorder

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to permit a diagnosis of post-traumatic stress disorder to satisfy the requirement in negligence actions that the plaintiff show actual injury.

An act relating to negligence actions and post-traumatic stress disorder

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this act is to overrule the Vermont Supreme Court's decision in *Zeno-Etheridge v. Comcast Corp.*, 219 Vt. 121 (2024) and permit a post-traumatic stress disorder diagnosis to satisfy the required element of a negligence claim that the plaintiff show actual injury.

Sec. 2. 12 V.S.A. § 1036a is added to read:

§ 1036a. NEGLIGENCE; ACTUAL INJURY; POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER

1 In any civil action, the required element in a negligence claim of actual
2 injury to the plaintiff may be satisfied by a diagnosis of post-traumatic stress
3 disorder.
