6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the  
7 operator of a fair stand to sell food for up to three days without paying a  
8 licensure fee.

9 An act relating to licensing fees for fair stands  
10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:  
11 Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4353 is amended to read:  
12 § 4353. FEES  
13 (a) The Commissioner may establish by rule any requirement the  
14 Department needs to determine the applicable categories or exemptions for  
15 licenses. The following license fees shall be paid annually to the Department  
16 at the time of making the application according to the following schedules:  
17 (1) Restaurants  
18 I — Seating capacity of 0 to 25; \$105.00  
19 II — Seating capacity of 26 to 50; \$180.00  
20 III — Seating capacity of 51 to 100; \$300.00
