3 Subject: Municipal and county government; municipal and regional planning
4 and development; variance; wheelchair ramps; accessibility

5 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that
6 appropriate municipal panels that perform development review allow property
7 owners to construct a wheelchair ramp without requiring property owners to
8 submit a zoning permit application. This bill also would require that
9 appropriate municipal panels receive education on the Americans with
10 Disabilities Act as it applies to municipal zoning.
