Subject: Alcoholic beverages, cannabis, and tobacco; licensing; retail licenses

and permits; second-class licenses; prohibition of the commingling of

alcoholic and nonalcoholic beverages in retail spaces; cannabis;

advertisement by cannabis establishments; study

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to articulate

Vermont's general health policies and amend various provisions of Title 7 to

align Vermont's system of alcoholic beverage and cannabis regulation with

those general health policies, including amendments that prohibit the holder of

an alcoholic beverage retail license from commingling alcoholic and

nonalcoholic beverages within the same retail display. This bill also proposes

to appropriate monies to the Cannabis Control Board to commission an

independent legal analysis of state regulation of cannabis advertising.
