Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to classify any  
incarcerated individual who performs labor for, at the direction of, or under the  
supervision of the Vermont Department of Corrections as a temporary State  
employee for the duration of that labor for the purpose of all labor- and  
employment-related rights, protections, and benefits, including wage and hour  
laws, workers' compensation, unemployment insurance, and collective  
bargaining.
