Subject: Health care; residential care homes; report

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the Agency of Human Services to submit a report to the General Assembly regarding the creation of one or more residential care homes, which may be level III or otherwise, for individuals exiting a hospital who cannot safely convalesce at home and who do not require a nursing home level of care. The report would identify whether there is a need for residential care homes, level III or otherwise, and if so, identify where the need is; identify how one or more residential care homes, level III or otherwise, might generate savings in the health care system; identify funding sources for residential care homes, level III or otherwise; and recommend how the Agency might partner with community-based organizations to develop residential care homes, level III or otherwise, as needed statewide.
