Subject: Human services; congregate housing; developmental or cognitive  
disability

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
Agency of Human Services to submit a report to the General Assembly  
regarding the creation of one or more congregate homes for adults with a  
developmental or cognitive disability. The report would identify whether there  
is a need for congregate homes for this population, and if so, identify where the  
need is; identify how one or more congregate homes might generate savings in  
the health care system; identify funding sources for congregate homes; and  
recommend how the Agency might partner with community-based  
organizations to develop congregate homes, as needed, statewide.
