16	(g) Gender identity. The State Registrar may correct or amend a death
17	certificate to reflect the deceased person's gender identity at the time of death
18	upon application by:
19	(1) the certifying licensed health care professional, medical examiner,
20	hospital, or nursing home; or

1	(2) the spouse, adult child, parent or guardian, adult sibling, or adult
2	grandchild of the deceased person.
3	(h) Rules. Pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25, the Department shall adopt
4	rules as necessary for the purposes of implementing, administering, or
5	enforcing the correction or amendment of death certificates pursuant to
6	subsection (g) of this section. The rules adopted pursuant to this subsection
7	shall include:
8	(1) a list of the documents that may be accepted as prima facie evidence

18	It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Department of Health,
19	exercising rulemaking authority pursuant to this act, shall adopt a
20	comprehensive procedure for a health care professional or surviving family
21	member to attest to the gender identity of a deceased person. The procedure

- 2 <u>the gender identity on a death certificate are resolved through the consideration</u>
