**S.C.R. 9.** Senate concurrent resolution extending the warmest 90th birthday and 30th anniversary wishes to former Rutland County Senators Judith E. Bloomer Crowley and John P. Crowley.

*Whereas*, Judy Wener was born on April 5, 1936, in Rutland and attended local public schools, Rutland Business College, and Boston Children's Hospital's nursing program, and

*Whereas*, she married Rutland attorney and future Senate President Pro Tempore John Bloomer, and they were the parents of one daughter and three sons, including the future Senate Republican Leader and Senate Secretary John Bloomer Jr., and

*Whereas*, in 1995, following her husband's unexpected death, the Governor appointed Judy Bloomer, who had voluntarily assisted her husband in the Senate Pro Tempore's office, to serve the balance of his Senate term, and her legislative colleagues elected her as a Vermont State Colleges trustee, and

*Whereas*, in 2000, after a two-term legislative hiatus, Judy Bloomer stood successfully for election to represent West Rutland in the House of Representatives (2001–2004), and she adeptly chaired a challenging special committee that examined ways to modernize municipal land records, and

*Whereas*, John P. Crowley was born in Rutland on April 14, 1936; graduated from Mount St. Joseph Academy, the College of the Holy Cross, Southeastern University, and Georgetown University Law Center; and he is a U.S. Army veteran and the father of a daughter and four sons, and

*Whereas*, his background as an attorney and accountant provided a strong foundation for representing Mendon in the House of Representatives (1993–1994), as well as for being a Rutland County Senator (1999–2003) and

Commissioner of the former Department of Banking, Insurance, Securities, and Health Care (2003–2007), and

*Whereas*, in May 1996, Judy Bloomer and John P. Crowley decided to start a new life together and married, and

*Whereas*, in April 2026, both partners of this civically engaged couple will joyously celebrate their respective 90th birthdays, and, in May of this year, they will observe, with great pleasure, their 30th wedding anniversary, *now therefore be it*
