





# Educational & Career Outcomes



## Since 2021:

2,162 participants

1,115 Credentials of Value/College Credit/IRCs

\$6.14 million dollars in wages & stipends

15,902 weeks of training and service

608 AmeriCorps members co-enrolled

## Last year:

543 participants (61% are 15-24 years old)

307 IRCs & 181 certificates/badges

50 earned college/HS credit or professional development CEU's

### **81 Habitat Assessment Projects:**

Including forest resilience and bird habitat assessment, priority bird monitoring, sugarbush assessment (Audubon VT/VYCC)

### **34 Community Education Projects:**


Including providing outdoor summer camp, afterschool programs. (Audubon VT)

### **40 Forestry & Habitat Improvement Projects:**

Including forest resilience and bird habitat assessment, priority bird monitoring, sugarbush assessment (Audubon VT/VYCC)

### **29 Small Build Projects**

Including building park benches, tables, bookshelves for local nonprofits & food pantries (VWW/ReSOURCE/VYCC/Audubon VT)



### **10 Accessible Housing Projects:**

Including basement repairs, siding projects, ramp/deck replacements, and full construction projects on low-income housing. (VWW/ReSOURCE/VYCC)

### **29 Outdoor Recreation Projects:**

Including trail maintenance, trail rerouting, infrastructure builds in state parks/state land. (VYCC)

### **9 Flood Recovery Projects:**

Including removing debris, removing moldy drywall, rebuilding low-income housing, repair of flood-damaged park infrastructure

### **22 Food Security Projects**

Including distributing food to 661 low-income families through the Health Care Share program (VYCC)





Participant Intentions for post-program career and educational plans?




**Of the 469 participants who completed their training in 2024**

- 99 were newly employed within 6 months of training completion
- 157 were continuing their education (returned high school, college or trade school)
- 20 entered another service opportunity
- 10 remained with their previous employer
- 6 indicated something “Other”.

*For participants in 2024, we had a 66% survey completion rate at the 6-month check-in point.*




