2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No.	
3	126 entitled "An act relating to health care payment and delivery system	
4	reform" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends	
5	that the report of the House Committee on Health Care be amended as follows:	
6	First: By striking out Sec. 11c, health care system transformation; incentives;	
7	telehealth, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 11c to read as	
8	follows:	
9	Sec. 11c. HEALTH CARE SYSTEM TRANSFORMATION; INCENTIVES;	
10	TELEHEALTH	
11	(a) To encourage hospitals to engage proactively, think expansively, and	
12	propose transformation initiatives that will reduce costs to Vermont's health	
13	care system without negatively affecting health care quality or jeopardizing	
14	access to necessary services, the Agency of Human Services shall award grants	
15	to the hospitals in State fiscal year 2026 that actively participate in health care	
16	transformation efforts to assist them in building partnerships, reducing hospital	
17	costs for hospital fiscal year 2026, and expanding Vermonters' access to health	
18	care services, including those delivered using telehealth. It is the intent of the	
19	General Assembly that the funds appropriated in Sec. 18(b) of this act should	
20	be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until all of the funds have been	
21	distributed.	

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2	(b) On or before November 15, 2025, the Agency of Human Services shall
3	report to the Health Reform Oversight Committee and the Joint Fiscal
4	Committee regarding how much of the \$2,000,000.00 appropriated to the
5	Agency pursuant to Sec. 18(b) of this act was obligated as of November 1,
6	2025 and how much had already been disbursed to hospitals as of that date.
7	Second: By adding striking out Sec. 17, effective dates, and its reader
8	assistance heading in their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
9	* * * Positions; Appropriations * * *
10	Sec. 17. GREEN MOUNTAIN CARE BOARD; POSITIONS
11	(a) The establishment of the following three new permanent classified
12	positions is authorized at the Green Mountain Care Board in fiscal year 2026:
13	(1) one Director, Reference-Based Pricing;
14	(2) one Project Manager, Reference-Based Pricing; and
15	(3) one Operations, Procurement, and Contractual Oversight Manager.
16	(b) These positions shall be transferred and converted from existing vacant
17	positions in the Executive Branch.
18	Sec. 18. APPROPRIATIONS
19	(a) The sum of \$2,200,000.00 is appropriated from the General Fund to the
20	Agency of Human Services in fiscal year 2026 for use as follows:

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1	(1) \$2,000,000.00 for feasibility analysis and transformation plan	
2	development with hospitals, designated agencies, primary care organizations,	
3	and other community-based providers;	
4	(2) \$100,000.00 for development of quality and access measures,	
5	targets, and monitoring strategies for the Statewide Health Care Delivery	
6	Strategic Plan; and	
7	(3) \$100,000.00 to support the development of alternative payment	
8	models.	
9	(b) Notwithstanding any provision of 32 V.S.A. § 10301 to the contrary,	
10	the sum of \$2,000,000.00 is appropriated from the Health IT-Fund to the	
11	Agency of Human Services in fiscal year 2026 for grants to hospitals for the	
12	collaborative efforts to reduce hospital costs in accordance with Secs. 11a and	
13	11c of this act and to expand access to health care services, such as by	
14	enhancing telehealth infrastructure development.	
15	(c)(1) The sum of \$1,062,500.00 is appropriated to the Green Mountain	
16	Care Board in fiscal year 2026 for use as follows:	
17	(A) \$512,500.00 for the positions authorized in Sec. 17 of this act, as	
18	set forth in subdivision (2) of this subsection (c);	
19	(B) \$500,000.00 from the General Fund for contracts, including	
20	contracts for assistance with implementing reference-based pricing in	
21	accordance with this act; and	

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1	(C) \$50,000.00 from the General Fund for a contract with the
2	Vermont Program for Quality in Health Care to engage in quality initiatives in
3	accordance with this act.
4	(2) Of the funds appropriated in subdivision (1)(A) of this subsection:
5	(A) \$205,000.00 is appropriated from the General Fund; and
б	(B) \$307,500.00 is appropriated from the Green Mountain Care
7	Board Regulatory and Administrative Fund.
8	(d) Notwithstanding any provision of 32 V.S.A. § 10301 to the contrary,
9	the sum of \$150,000.00 is appropriated from the Health IT-Fund to the Green
10	Mountain Care Board in fiscal year 2026 for expenses associated with
11	increased standardization of electronic hospital budget data submissions in
12	accordance with Sec. 4 of this act.

14	Sec. 19. EFFECTIVE DATES
15	(a) Secs. 16 (18 V.S.A. § 9375(d); Green Mountain Care Board annual
16	report), 17 (Green Mountain Care Board; positions), and 18 (appropriations)
17	shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
18	(b) The remaining sections shall take effect on passage.
