2 TECHNOLOGY INTERNAL SERVICE FUND; DEFICIT  
3 MITIGATION PLAN

4 (a) On or before January 15, 2027, the Agency of Digital Services shall,  
5 in consultation with the Department of Finance and Management, provide a  
6 written plan to the House Committees on Appropriations and on Energy and  
7 Digital Infrastructure and the Senate Committees on Appropriations and on  
8 Institutions on how to reduce the deficit in the Information Technology  
9 Internal Service Fund established by 3 V.S.A. § 3304, including any  
10 recommended changes to revenue sources to and expenditures from the Fund.  
11 The report shall include information on revenues to and expenditures from the  
12 Fund and the Fund's balance at fiscal year closeout for the previous 10 fiscal  
13 years. The report shall also include the most current available information on  
14 revenues to and expenditures from the Fund and the estimated Fund balance at  
15 fiscal year 2027 closeout.

1 Sec. E.136.1 STATE ETHICS COMMISSION; ATTORNEY; MUNICIPAL  
2 CODE OF ETHICS

3 (a)(1) Of the General Fund appropriation in Sec. B.136.1 of this act, up to  
4 \$140,000 may be used by the State Ethics Commission to fund the permanent,  
5 exempt Staff Attorney position established by Sec. E.100(a)(2)(A)(i) of this  
6 act, who will prioritize the Commission's obligations in providing education,  
7 training, guidance, and advice to persons subject to the State Code of Ethics  
8 and the Municipal Code of Ethics.

9 (2) Any remaining spending authority may be used by the State Ethics  
10 Commission to fund operating expenses, including the purchase of equipment  
11 and supplies.
