Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) – Overview

- U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Office of Community Services
- Flexible funding source
- Broad goals:
 - Reduce dependency and promote self-sufficiency
 - Protect children and adults from neglect, abuse, and exploitation
 - Help individuals who are unable to take care of themselves in their homes, or to find the most appropriate setting for their care

Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) – FFY25

- Planned SSBG Expenditures: \$3,081,826
- States may transfer up to 10% of TANF to SSBG
 - TANF Transfer: \$4,719,688
- Grand Total: \$7,801,514

Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) FFY25 Services and Allocations

- DCF - \$5,738,982
 - Counseling Services - \$278,590
 - Day Care Services – Children - \$4,719,688 (TANF transfer total)
 - Foster Care Services for Children - \$740,704
- DAIL - \$947,576
 - Day Care Services – Adults - \$130,000
 - Protective Services for Adults - \$817,576
