Submitted EWBB so far - waiting for NOA. CAPS Infra & Survey are foundation for Ben's funding- this is not competitive and has been level funded. The Plant Protection Act funding is competitive. These are annual awards that fall on different timeframes. We have been told that we will receive the same amount as last year with possibly a 3% increase in funding (CAPS Infra & Survey). This also supports ADT and Umbrella Grants in FSCP - Animal Health.

NRCS CREP. Usually we would be provided a continuation (amendment to current agreement). At this point we do not know whether or not we will be provided the opportunity for a continuation. Data is collected from Farmer's Markets, Organic Dairy, Maple & Meat Producers.

Combined CIG and NRCS SWAT. The NRCS CIG's purpose is to provide agricultural soil health, and agricultural greenhouse gas tracking, quantification, verification, and reporting for the State of Vermont utilizing the Farm Phosphorus Reduction Planner (Farm-PREP). The NRCS SWAT grant provides engineering and technical assistance for farm operations (between 30-50 farms per year).

RCPP - match was already met for this current grant award. We do not know whether or not this funding opportunity will be available. We do not know whether or not we will be provided a continuation of this grant.
