Impact of APRA Investment

Funding leveraged primarily from federal tax credits and conventional debt

Farm and Forest Viability Program: ARPA Water Quality Grants



ARPA Award: \$600,000

Purpose: Grants to farmers for water quality infrastructure projects on farms.

ARPA Expended:

- **\$480,000** to **14** farm projects leveraging an additional **\$3,051,501** in state, federal and local funds

General Fund Revenue Replacement:

- **\$120,000** fully committed to **3** farm projects underway
