10	Subject: Commerce and trade; consumer protection; musical performances
11	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to enhance
12	consumer protection in the event ticketing market by regulating the resale of
13	tickets through improved transparency and the prevention of predatory and
14	deceptive practices. The bill proposes to require entities that resell or facilitate
15	the resale of tickets to guarantee to each purchaser a full refund under certain
16	circumstances; to provide clear, itemized price details, including taxes and
17	fees; to prohibit selling tickets that a reseller does not own or have under
18	contract, unless the reseller provides notice to the purchaser in a clear and
19	conspicuous manner; and to prohibit the use of ticket purchasing software or
20	other methods to bypass online sales limits or other security measures. The
21	bill also proposes to require annual licensing for ticket resellers, require those

1	resellers to maintain a minimum surety bond to cover consumer losses, and
2	require the maintenance of certain records regarding resale transactions.
3	Finally, the bill proposes to provide enforcement authority with the Office of
4	the Attorney General and authorizes the Attorney General to conduct audits for
5	compliance, to issue administrative penalties, and to revoke or suspend a
6	reseller's license under appropriate circumstances. Violations shall constitute
7	an unfair and deceptive act in commerce in violation of 9 V.S.A. § 2453.
