Arts & Culture Contributed Nearly \$1.2 Billion to the Vermont Economy




- In 2022, the Vermont arts and culture sector was a nearly \$1.2 billion industry, a 10% increase from 2021.
- The industry represents 3% of Vermont's GSP and accounts for 10,574 jobs.

- Arts and culture **generated \$158.6 million in economic activity** during 2022.
- Arts and culture event audiences are
 75% locals and 25% nonlocal.
- 79% of nonlocal audiences say they traveled specifically to attend a cultural event.
