## **Rural Technical Assistance Supports Community Vitality**

VCRD and Our Partners Urge the Legislature to  
**include a \$500,000 appropriation to support rural  
technical assistance in the State's FY'27 budget.**

coordinated navigation support and flexible funding to Vermont's rural  
towns to achieve community priorities aligned with state goals*

## WHAT THE PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE

- **Flexible municipal support:** Meaningful, flexible grants for town-specific projects focused on community and economic development initiatives such as childcare, housing, water/wastewater, climate resilience or other community priorities
- **TA navigation and wraparound support:** TA providers and consultants will coordinate their services and provide navigation support to communities in the cohort
- **Evaluation and learning:** Ongoing assessment to refine program design, improve statewide TA service delivery, and implement recommendations in the VERTA report

## PROGRAM DESIGN

- VERTA report plus combined decades of experience on Steering Committee+
- Core concepts and principles:
  - Community driven
  - Coordinated TA services
  - Flexible funding
  - Complementary to state development goals
